**We offer families to apply for variable tuition which is a tuition discount. To apply families must complete a non-refundable \$40 application fee. If approved, families will receive tuition amount within 10 business days of verification of income.

If a student withdraws from school before the end of the year or before the school year starts, tuition is due for the months attended PLUS one additional month (tuition is calculated by taking annual tuition and dividing it by 9 months, this is the actual cost for one month). Application, registration and fees are non-refundable. If enrolling after 9/1/26, tuition will be prorated appropriately.
