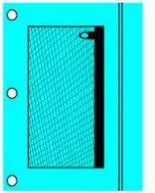
- A **ONE-inch CLEAR PLASTIC COVER 3 Ring Binder**

- Please make sure this is a ONE INCH binder. ½ inch binders do not hold everything and 1.5 inch binders are too big for the shelf.
- This binder will be separate from your other classes & remain in the Elective Room.
- The binder must have a plastic cover so we can slip your name label underneath it for the year. No zipper binders either please.
- Returning students may leave their name labels from last year.

- **3 Ring Zipper Pencil Pouch JUST for Spanish binder**

- This must be able to attach inside the 3 ring binder & will be separate from your other classes.
- Please make sure the pencil pouch lines up with the 3 ring prongs. When only 2 of the holes line up, this makes it challenging to flip through the binder throughout the year.

- **2 pencils (sharpened inside pencil pouch).**

Every grade is going to help supply a different need. Please read the supply list below carefully, noting what your student will need to bring depending on the grade they're entering.

- **ALL GRADES** – 22x28 plain white paper poster board
- Kindergarten – 1 roll of paper towels
- 1st Grade – 1 pack of ten skinny/fine point markers
- 2nd Grade – 1 bottle of Elmer's glue (liquid glue, **not** glue stick)
- 3rd Grade – 4 glue sticks
- 4th Grade – 24 pack of colored pencils + **two** pencil sharpeners
- 5th Grade – Stack of large **black** construction paper (12 x 18in)
- Middle School – Pad of **mixed media** paper (9 x 12in)
